HOWARD

CHAD

Yeah, but it's a great old building. Plus the park.

HOWARD

- No...Right. Yeah. It's terrific.

CHAD

- Still doing a little touch-up.

HOWARD

Yeah Looks like you got a new frame there for the "Gigolo." It looks good. It's almost got...and I mean this the right way...a woman's touch.

CHAD

Thank you, Howard.

HOWARD

Sure.

CHAD

So what is it?

HOWARD

HOWARD

HOWARD

Look! It's Christine. I'm here. Gotta talk, because of her.

CHAD

- You did it, right?

HOWARD

- Did what?

CHAD

- Told her.

HOWARD

- Yeah. It just sort of...

CHAD

Kind of caught me off guard, you know?
Might of said something to me first. I thought
it was an unwritten that we'd keep the mechanics
of it to ourselves. So she said that you told
her everything.

HOWARD

- Yes.

CHAD

- And?

HOWARD

- Come on, Chad.

CHAD

HOWARD

- Jesus. She just fell apart.

CHAD

- You told her that 1...

HOWARD

CHAD

HOWARD

CHAD

HOWARD

CHAD

HOWARD

- Chad.

CHAD

HOWARD

CHAD
