DEBI

MARTIN

MARTIN

DEBI

DEBI

DEBI

DEBI

You're pathetic. You know what you need?

MARTIN

What?

DEBI

Shakabuku!

MARTIN

You wanna tell me what that means?

DEBI

It's a swift, spiritual kick to the head that alters your reality forever.

MARTIN

Oh, that'd be good... I think. So listen. I was thinking I could pick you up for the reunion at around seven and we'd go---

DEBI

Wait a minute! Let me get this straight... you're asking me to go as your date to the reunion?

MARTIN

Yes

DEBI

Unbelievable!

MARTIN

Well, you, what the hell?

DEBI

You know I'm not even planning on going?

MARTIN

Really?

DEBI

Really. I was just going to be mean about it on the radio. Besides, it's going to be depressing.

MARTIN

DEBI
