KNOWN COLLECTIVELY AS THE **BLACKFOOT CONFEDERACY** -THERE ARE FOUR DISTINCT BANDS (GROUPS): THE **SIKSIKA**(NEAR CALGARY, ALBERTA), THE **KAINAI** (NEAR LETHBRIDGE, ALBERTA),
THE NORTHERN **PIKANI** (NEAR PINCHER CREEK, ALBERTA)
AND THE SOUTHERN **PIKUNI** (BROWNING, MONTANA)

NAPI & THE ROCK ALSO TELLS THE STORY OF **HOW THE RANDOM MASSIVE ROCK FORMATIONS**, THAT YOU'LL FIND SCATTERED THROUGHOUT

THE PRAIRIES, **CAME TO BE**.

YOU CAN ACTUALLY VISIT THE SITE OF NAPI AND THE ROCK -- THERE'S EVEN AN INFO DISPLAY AND REMNANTS OF THE ROCK. BLACKFOOT PEOPLE CALL IT "OKOTOK" (BIG ROCK), BUT, IT'S FORMALLY KNOWN AS THE "OKOTOKS ERRATICS". A SHORT DRIVE WEST OF OKOTOKS, ALBERTA AND YOU'LL FIND IT.
