SUMMONS

TO THE DEFENDANTS:

1 A lawsuit has been started against you in the above-entitled court by THE  
2 PRESBYTERY OF SEATTLE, THE FIRST PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH OF  
3 SEATTLE, ROBERT WALLACE, and WILLIAM LONGBRAKE (collectively,  
4 “plaintiffs). Plaintiffs’ claim is stated in the written complaint, a copy of which is served  
5 upon you with this summons.

7 In order to defend against this lawsuit, you must respond to the complaint by  
8 stating your defense in writing, and by serving a copy upon the person signing this  
9 summons within 20 days after the service of this summons, excluding the day of service,  
10 or a default judgment may be entered against you without notice. A default judgment is  
11 one where plaintiffs are entitled to what they ask for because you have not responded. If  
12 you serve a notice of appearance on the undersigned person, you are entitled to notice  
13 before a default judgment may be entered.  
14

15 You may demand that the plaintiffs file this lawsuit with the court. If you do so,  
16 the demand must be in writing and must be served upon the person signing this summons.  
17 Within 14 days after you serve the demand, the plaintiffs must file this lawsuit with the  
18 court, or the service on you of this summons and complaint will be void.

19 If you wish to seek the advice of an attorney in this matter, you should do so  
20 promptly so that your written response, if any, may be served on time.
