Discipleship with Monday in Mind Notes

A book dealing with: **Faith and Vocation** - Churches and pastors discovering how to have conversations that connect faith and vocation.

Editors share where they discovered **THREE** reasons they realized/recovered the need for this:

1. The Marketplace - This is where the church lives most of the week
2. The Millennials - marrying later/more time vs church focus on family
3. Biblical/Church History - History of pastors /the church talking about it.

FOUR things we can do to help make the connection for our members:

1. Practice less download and more upload (in our CGs).
2. Get Curious as leader
3. Get Offsite and learn to live Life on Life.
4. Prayer/Counsel - Help others connect the metanarrative to vocation.

Connecting Vocation to the Metanarrative of Scripture: Creation, Fall, Redemption, Restoration

1. Through Example Questions

EXAMPLE SET #1

1. What type of work do you do?
2. How do you try to do that work as a Christian?
3. How does sin seem to affect that work?
4. How do you try to serve your neighbors through your work?
5. How can we pray for you?

EXAMPLE SET #2

1. What type of work do you do?
2. How did you feel called to do what you're doing?
3. What are certain opportunities or obstacles you're facing in your work?
4. How does your faith speak to those obstacles?
5. How can we pray for you?

EXAMPLE SET #3

1. How do you co-create with God through the work that you do?
2. Where do you experience the Fall and brokenness?
3. Where do you experience restoration/redemption through the word that you do?
4. How do you sense that your work is part of God's greater work?
