



ENGL 101 – English Composition Syllabus

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR EACH CLASS:

STUDENT QUESTIONS: *ALL* class questions should be submitted via the form provided on the course link page. Someone will typically respond to your request with 24-48 hours, if not sooner.

COURSE COMPLETION TIME FRAME: Students are given a maximum time limit of 6 months to complete once you have started any course. After 6 months, you will be required to contact info@westcoastbible.org to receive a new course for your degree plan that you will be required to purchase. *(This applies even if you have PAID IN FULL for the degree)*

SUBMISSIONS: Students will not allowed to submit more than 18 assignments in any month for any reason. Failure to adhere to this policy will result in a 1-month temporary suspension of submission privileges. Repeat offenders will face a 3-month and then 6-month suspension.

GRADING: All assignments will be graded immediately upon the submission of the online assignments. It is the student's responsibility to keep a printed copy of all scoring results in case there is a grading conflict. ***WCBBCS will only keep results for up to 6 months.*** Any scoring discrepancies need to be noted within 1 week of the course being marked as completed.

FAILURE POLICY: Any student who makes **BELOW A SCORE OF 50 ON ANY ASSIGNMENT WILL AUTOMATICALLY FAIL THE COURSE** and ***will be required to pay for a new course.*** *(This includes anyone who had paid in full – you will be required to pay the cost of a single class for each applicable course)*

CHEATING POLICY: Any student found cheating will be given the grade of "F" for the course and will be required to take a different course. If the cheating occurs more than one time, the student will be permanently expelled with NO REFUND!

MODULES TO BE COMPLETED AND SUBMITTED ONLINE FOR THIS COURSE

1) READING & KEY TRUTHS (20% of final grade)

You are **REQUIRED** to fully read the textbook and to write down on key truth (thought) from your daily reading. *(If more than one chapter is assigned for the daily reading, you will only need one key truth per daily reading)* Each key truth should be a complete thought/sentence that you would be able to remember what it means 10 years down the line if you were to read it again. It should detail something important you learned reflecting the reading material.

2) COURSE LECTURES (20% of final grade)

You are **REQUIRED** to listen fully to the course lectures. Before listening, you are encouraged to download the lecture notes as a resource to assist you in the filling in the blanks for the 10 points you will be tested on in the online Lecture Note Quiz. Once you have completed the lecture notes, take the online multiple-choice quiz. **You are REQUIRED to completely listen to the lectures.**

3) OPEN BOOK EXAM (20% of final grade)

Before reading, you are encouraged to download the *Open Book Exam* as a resource to assist you in the filling in the blanks for the questions you will be tested on in the online *Open Book Exam*. Questions will come directly from the book. Upon completion of reading the assigned text and answering of the questions, take the online test to submit and receive your testing score.

4) MAGAZINE ARTICLES ASSIGNMENT & QUIZ (20% of final grade)

You are **REQUIRED** to read the 5 assigned magazine articles listed on the class link page, highlighting or taking notes from what you have read. Upon completion you will take the *Magazine Quiz* that is made up of 5 questions, 1 from each article.

5) VIDEOS & FINAL PAPER ASSIGNMENT (20% of final grade)

You are **REQUIRED** to fully watch the YouTube/Vimeo links provided assigned for this course. The links can all be found on your class link page. As you are watching the videos, you should take notes and be prepared to submit a total of 9 key truths on the final paper assignment. *(The other questions will ask if you watched all of the videos. This is an integrity issue, so be truthful! It is better to lose a letter grade than to lose your integrity)*

Daily Class Schedule

Day 1: Read Chapter 1 -- write down one key truth you learned

Day 2: Read Chapter 2 -- write down one key truth you learned

Day 3: Read Chapter 3-- write down one key truth you learned

Day 4: Read Chapter 4 -- write down one key truth you learned

Day 5: Read Chapter 5 - write down one key truth you learned

Day 6: Read Chapter 6 - write down one key truth you learned

(Complete the online assignment that states you read the book and have written one key truth as prescribed in the Daily Class Schedule. You are REQUIRED to submit your key truths online when taking the quiz. Please maintain your integrity in this process!!!)

Day 7: Listen to lecture #1 and fill in the blanks

Day 8: Listen to lecture #2 and fill in the blanks

(Complete the lecture notes multiple-choice quiz online)

Day 9: Complete open-book exam

(Complete exam on your paper and then take the exam online. Note: Be careful to make sure you spell all words correctly and that you do not leave extra spaces when filling in the blanks as this will result in an incorrect answer.)

Day 10: Complete Magazine Articles Assignment & Quiz

Day 11-14: Complete Videos & Final Paper Assignment
