

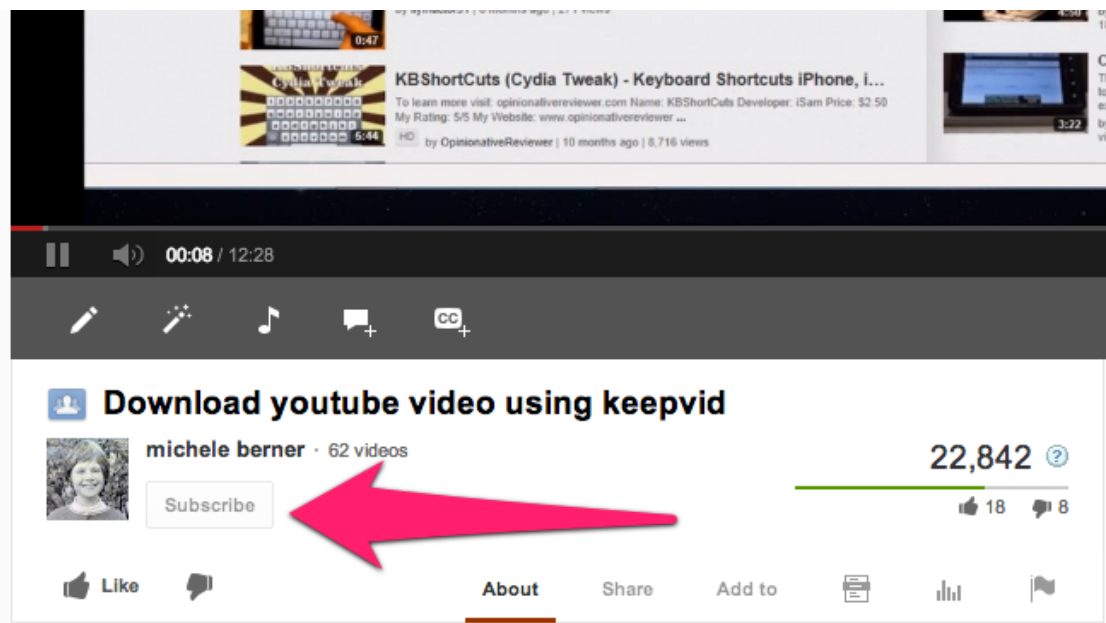

### Signup for accounts

- Dropbox.com
- Google drive (a google account)
- Windows Skydrive
- Box.com

### Youtube

- Download the Youtube app from the App store
- On the computer: Get a Youtube account – Go to Youtube.com
- Create a playlist – use the computer to create the playlist
- Favourite a video
  - Locate the video – Using Goodreader to go paperless:

  - Save it to your Favourites
- Download video from Youtube
  - If you want to download this video, you need to use the site: keepvid.com from a computer. There is no way to download video from the iPad.

- Subscribe to a channel:
- Subscribe to my Youtube channel. Each time there is a new video you will see it your Youtube homepage.

## **iTunes**

Settings and preferences in iTunes

### **Play region-blocked TV on your iPad**

- Create another iTunes account – UK or US
- On your iPad, change to the UK iTunes store and download the BBC iPlayer
- Using tunlr.net, change the DNS settings in your iPad and watch a program from the BBC iPlayer

### **Getting media into your iPad**

- Download a video using keepvid.com from the computer
- Import the file to iTunes
- Save it to a memory stick

## Moving files

### Using Adobe Reader

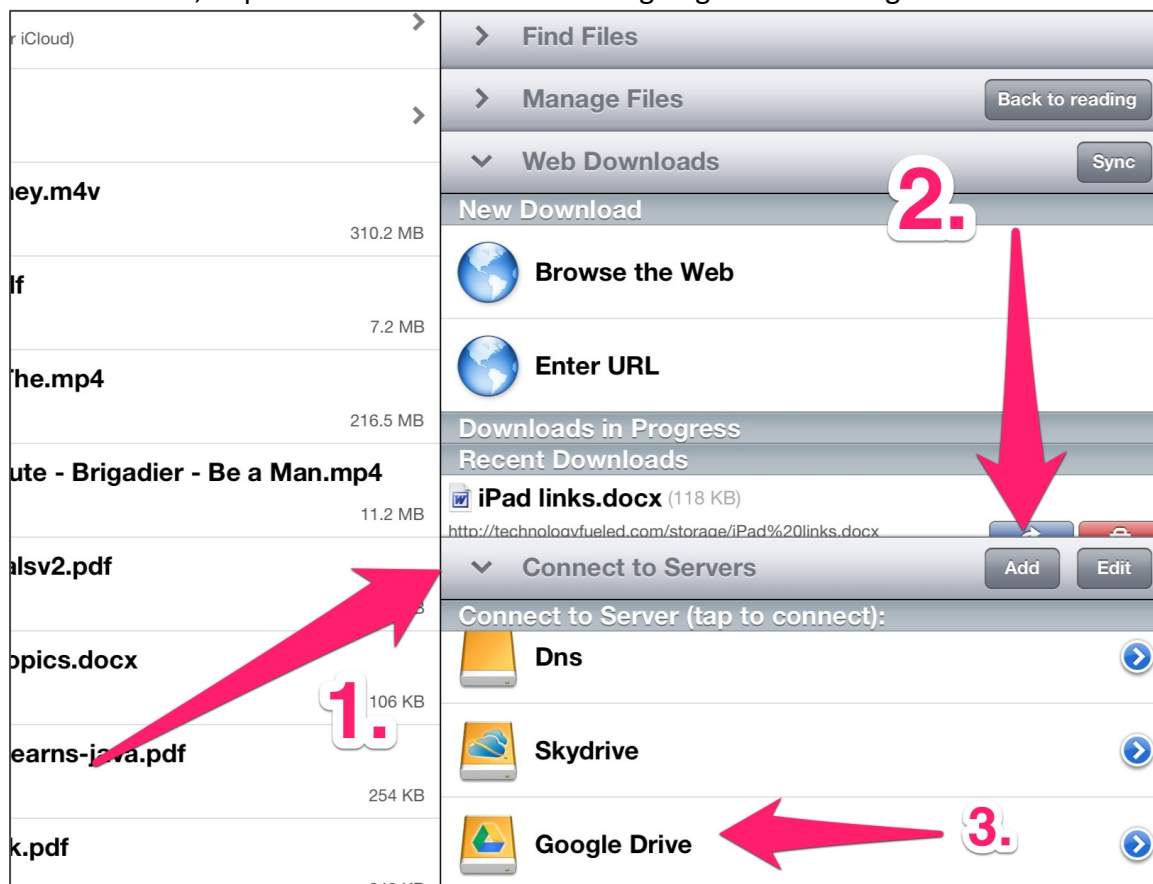
1. Download a file from this link: <http://technologyfueled.com/class-files/>
  - From Safari, enter the link
  - Tap to open the file. The file will download to your iPad
  - Tap the screen and select "Open In..."
  - Select Adobe Reader.
2. Open the file in Notability.
  - Import as New note. Just select one page
  - Make some changes eg draw something, add some notes and
  - Save the amended file to either Dropbox, Box or Google Drive.

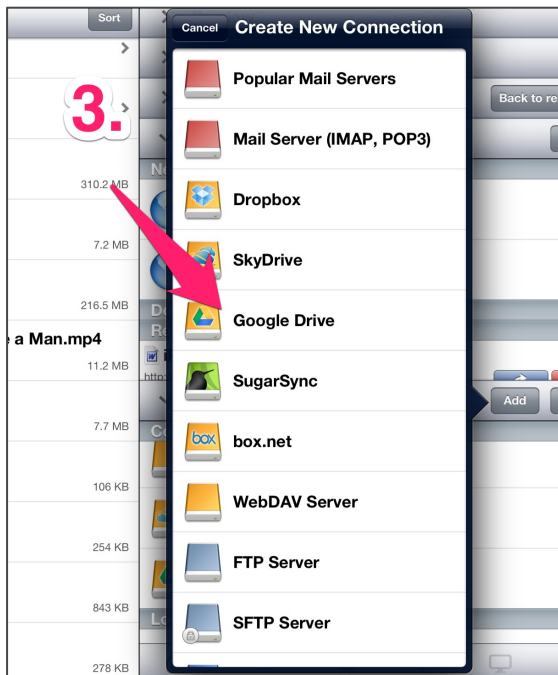
### Using FileExplorer

1. Connect to Michele's computer. Download a photo from the public folder
2. Using iCloud to save files (make sure you have Documents and Data enabled in iCloud settings)
3. Move a file from a cloud service. Add your Dropbox account and download a file.

### Using Goodreader

In Goodreader, tap **Connect to Servers**. You are going to add a Google Drive server





The same process can be used to add a server for: Windows Skydrive, box.net and dropbox
