

Summer Olympic Math Program

Your child has the opportunity to participate in a summer math program, which is designed to sharpen math skills and make the transition back to school easier. The program is simple and allows your child to work on paper or on the computer. One point is awarded for each printed math sheet and for each game played on the computer. You can download fact sheets or worksheets from the Internet. For computer games that allow you to work freely (not within a single game format), one point is awarded for every 25 problems solved. Document your child's games on the recording sheet. On Friday of the first week of school, all math points must be submitted to your child's teacher. You are welcome to explore other math resources and submit them for points as well. There will be a top winner in each grade.
