

# Afternoon Enrichment Program

- All programs are privately contracted through our individual instructors. It is the responsibility of the parent to directly contact the instructor to set up and pay for lessons.
- All instruction (except for voice) is on campus, either in the side rooms of the fellowship hall or in one of the lower school classrooms. The fellowship hall is located on the main floor of Eastwood Presbyterian Church.
- Check with your child's instructor concerning arrangements for lunch. All students are required to register for the After Care program if the instructor does not provide for a supervised lunch, or if you do not intend to stay with your child until time for his or her lesson. Your child is also required to return to the After Care program immediately following a lesson unless you plan to come inside and check your child out with his or her instructor.
