Now Hiring Camp Shelanu Staff!

Camp Shelanu - Congregation B'nai Israel's summer day camp program - is looking for dedicated, fun, and creative camp staff! If you like to play, sing, create, and laugh with campers ages 5 to 15, we want you to be part of our Camp Shelanu team. It's the perfect summer job for high school and college students!

Our camp consists of five one-week sessions plus staff training and post-camp breakdown - employment dates are June 26 through August 4. **You must be available for the entire timeframe.**

POSITIONS AVAILABLE:

Senior Camp Counselors- Salary range: \$1400 - \$1600

Must be at least 18 and have camp or related experience. Senior counselor has direct responsibility for a group of campers, the supervision of a junior counselor and/or a counselor-in-training. Responsibilities consist of planning and implementing group activities, leading games, and supervising campers at all times. Working knowledge of Jewish culture strongly preferred. Applicants must be enthusiastic and responsible when working with peers, campers, and parents.

Junior Camp Counselors- Salary range: \$1000 - \$1200

Responsibilities include planning and leading activities for your group of campers, modeling leadership for C.I.T.s assigned to group. A working knowledge of Jewish culture and tradition strongly preferred. Must be entering 11th or 12th grade. Camp experience strongly preferred, as well as experience working with kids.

Child Care Worker- Rate of pay: \$10/hour

Must be at least 18 and available to work from 7:30 – 9am and/or from 4 – 6pm, Monday – Friday. Should have experience and ability to lead age-appropriate day care activities.

Lifeguard- Rate of Pay: Depends on experience and time commitment

Must have lifeguard certification and CPR training. Responsibilities include overseeing the onsite inflatable pools and travelling with Camp Shelanu on field trips involving water. Attention to detail and ability to intently focus while standing is incredibly important. Lifeguard could also be a camp counselor if desired.
