

LADDERED CLOTHS

With
Wool



There are times when a pretty ball of cotton yarn is quite irresistible. Though with this pattern at hand, that ball will be a handy cloth very quickly.

Sizes

7"x15", 7"x7", 5"x5"

Gauge

5 sts = 1"

Materials & Notions

Worsted Weight Cotton (98, 50, 26 yds)

Shown in Pisgah Peaches & Cream Ombre -
York Town; Lily Sugar'n Cream - *Warm Brown*

US 6 (4mm) needles

Tapestry Needle

Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

sl = slip

wyif = with yarn in front

st(s) = stitch(es)

Note: Below I've given the numbers for 3 different sizes; however, if you'd like to make something larger, smaller, or in between, the stitch pattern is a multiple of 6 sts combined with 6 (4+2) edge sts.

For the kitchen towel and washcloth, cast on 36 sts using the long tail cast on.

For a coaster, cast on 24 sts with the long tail cast on.

Knit 5 rows.

Row 1: k4, *p4, k2*, repeat between * until 2 sts remain, k2

Row 2: k4 *k1, sl2 wyif, k3* repeat between * until 2 sts remain, k2

Repeat Rows 1 and 2, ending on Row 2, until the cloth is .5" short of the desired length or:

for a kitchen towel: 14.5"

for a washcloth: 6.5"

for a coaster: 4.5"

Knit 5 rows, bind off, and weave in ends.
