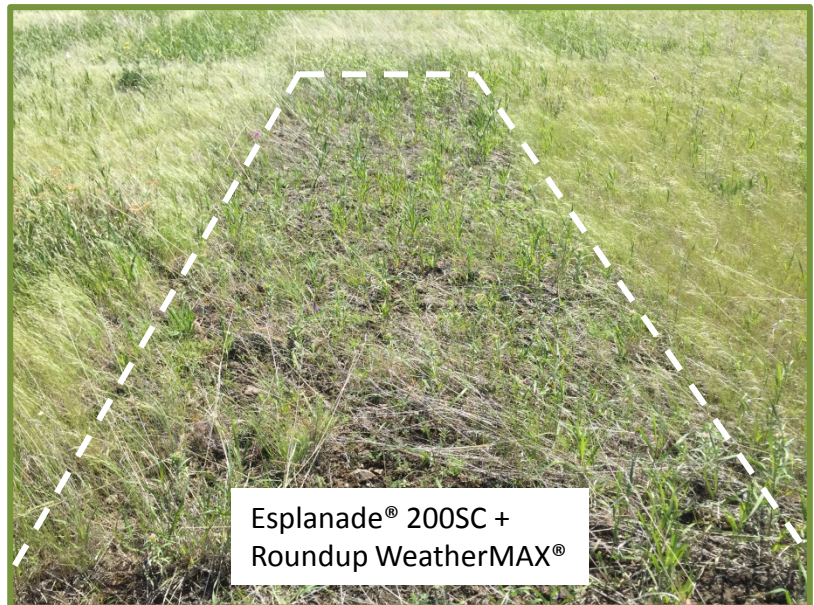


Ventenata Management Field Day

Washington State University Extension

Thursday July 19 2018

Come and learn about the latest research for restoring ventenata infested natural areas and rangeland. The field day will cover ventenata control trials established since the spring of 2016. You will see the effects of both new and established herbicide options. After attending this tour you will have a better understanding of herbicides, tank mix options, and application timings for ventenata control. You will also see the devastating effects ventenata has on desirable perennial grasses and the rapid response of the perennial grasses and forbs to removal of ventenata competition.



TOUR PROGRAM Thursday July 19, 2018

The tour will begin at 8 a.m. leaving from Asotin City Park, Washington. We will consolidate transportation at Asotin City Park and visit Washington State University (WSU) Extension Ventenata Research Trials near Anatone, WA. We will have a WSU 10 passenger van if you want to ride with us. All transportation will return to Asotin City Park at noon.
