Injection/aspiration of large joint, bursa, and/or trigger point	1	2

Colposcopy with biopsy	1	5

US guided IJ central line placement	1	5
Femoral central line placement	1	5
Subclavian central line placement	1	5

Recommended OR procedures

1. Skin closure using sutures (simple interrupted or subcuticular), tissue glue & steri-strips, or staples
2. CCY
3. Hernia repair - inguinal, femoral, and/or umbilical/ventral
4. Bariatric surgery, gastric bypass and/or lap banding
5. Breast lumpectomy with or without lymph node dissection
6. colorectal - perirectal abscess I&D, colectomy, ostomy placement and/or takedown
