It is highly recommended that you and your child read this information together.

The Parental Consent Form for Medical Treatment and the Medical History Report are important forms needed in the case of an emergency and will be used for all band trips, especially out of state trips. **All forms are due Monday, May 1, 2017.**

The Parental Consent Form must have a raised-seal notary stamp. This service is available at area banks or credit unions. **Very Important: Wait to sign the form until you are in front of the notary, and bring your driver's license.** These forms are important for medical treatment within Michigan and especially for any out of state trip. We can not stress enough the importance of having all medical forms in hand and completed properly when it comes to getting any necessary medical treatment for our band students!

The last item in the Medical History Report asks for the date of the student's last physical examination. If the student has not had a physical exam within the last several years, it is highly recommended that you make an appointment and put down that date. If your child has been ill and gone to the doctor within the last year, you may use that date. If at any time there is information that changes (or if you have any questions concerning the forms) please call Sue Jonker (667-3369) or e mail - sjonker@jpsonline.org.

A reminder to athletes: The Band Parental Consent and Medical History forms can NOT be used as a physical form for Jenison High School athletes.

Code of Conduct 2017-18

In addition to all the policies and expectations laid out in the Jenison High School Band Handbook (available online at jenisonbands.org), Marching Band students will be held to high standards in terms of their academic responsibilities, attendance at school as well as at all marching band rehearsals and performances, and responsible behavior both on and off campus. This Code of Conduct has been created to improve the Jenison Marching Band as an organization by insisting that each member upholds these high standards, and therefore consistently contributes positively to our "team."

School Attendance Expectations

Our students' top priority must be successful completion of their secondary school education. Students must make every effort to be in attendance the full day of, or day before, any marching band performance. Attendance at school means a full day. Arriving to school late is not acceptable. Leaving school early to rest is not acceptable.

Several times in the fall season, the marching band travels beyond the local area to participate in Saturday competitions. Students may return to Jenison very late at night or even very early Sunday morning. All students are expected to be in attendance at school the following Monday.

If school absenteeism is a problem, the band directors or school administration may deny the student the opportunity to participate in marching band.

Academic Expectations

Marching band students will be expected to maintain a minimum GPA of 2.0. Students who drop below this GPA will meet with the band directors to develop an academic improvement plan.

While students are not allowed to miss marching band rehearsals or performances because of heavy homework/study loads, marching band rehearsals or travel schedules are *never* an excuse for a student to neglect his or her academic responsibilities.

Behavior Expectations

At ALL times both in and out of rehearsal, on or off campus, marching band members will conduct themselves as dignified young people, making responsible choices that reflect positively on our program.

- Members will treat each other, staff members, and parent volunteers with courtesy and respect.
- The Jenison Marching Band strictly enforces a No Bullying policy. Bullying includes gossip, back talk, arguing, physical confrontation, hazing, taunting and mocking.
- Use of social media such as Twitter, Facebook, etc. must be in line with standards of conduct in person and on campus.

- The use of tobacco, alcohol, e-cigarettes or drugs by students is illegal and will NOT be tolerated in the Jenison Band.

Actions and choices which bring discredit to the student, parents, band program, or Jenison High School WILL have consequences, up to and including expulsion from the Jenison Band.

Rehearsal Expectations

- All members will be on time for each rehearsal. ("On time" means on the field ready to go with all necessary equipment at the designated start time.)
- The use of cell phones during rehearsal is prohibited unless directed otherwise by a staff member (for use as a tuner etc.).
- Members will not bring personal issues or negative discussions into the rehearsal environment.

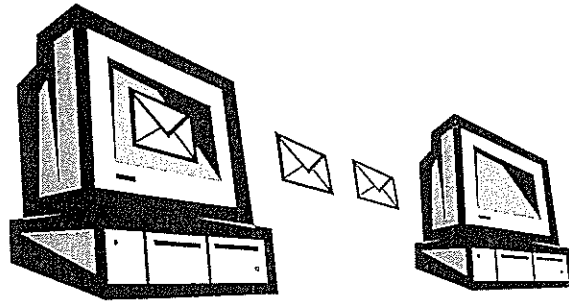

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

It is understood that participation in the Michigan Competing Band Competition (the "Event") November 4, 2017 (Date) has inherent dangers. In consideration for the opportunity of _____, a minor (the "Minor"), to participate in the Event, I (we) the undersigned parent(s) or guardian of the Minor, hereby expressly release and forever discharge, on behalf of the Minor, the undersigned and their family, heirs, assigns and personal representative, all participating groups and other persons, including Ford Field Management, LLC, Ford Field Condominium Association, Ford Field Management Company, Ford Field Enterprises, DLI Properties, LLC, DLI Properties, Inc., DLI Management, Inc., DLI Parking, LLC, DLI Office Realty, LLC, DLI Entertainment, LLC, DLI Parking Realty, LLC, The Detroit Lions, Inc., Detroit Lions Charities, Detroit Lions Properties, FFP Investment Company, LLC, S.A.F.E. Management, LLC, City of Detroit, Downtown Detroit Development Authority, Detroit/Wayne County Stadium Authority, Wayne County, and their respective officers, directors, board members, employees, councilpersons, contractors, and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims, damages and costs arising from or related in any way to the Minor's participation in the Event and/or the Released Parties' negligence, including, without limitation, any bodily and personal injuries, however caused.

Jenison Bands Attendance Policies

(taken from the Jenison Bands Handbook, available online at www.jenisonbands.org)

NOTIFICATION OF ABSENCES FOR A PERFORMANCE

All concerts, festivals and marching band performances are required. These performances are equivalent to major tests in band. An absence from a performance requires a telephone call or email to the band director(s) from the parent(s). A calendar of all known events for the school year has been made available to students and parents, and is ALWAYS available on our website, www.jenisonbands.org. Any changes to the schedule will always be announced in class, posted in the band room, and published on the website. It is the responsibility of both the student and parents not to schedule other events that conflict with band performances or rehearsals. Any known conflicts with these performances require a phone call or email from a parent to Mr. Zamborsky or Mr. Kline at least one week before the event, but preferably as soon as a conflict is found. Any emergency situation also requires a phone call or email. When leaving a message regarding an absence on the Band Office phone, **the reason for the absence must be given**. A director will call or email back if there is a question.

Excused absences will not receive a penalty; the student will receive full credit. Excused absences will be granted as follows:

Death in the Immediate Family - Parents contact the director by phone, by email, or in person as soon as possible **before** the absence.

Student Illness - Parents contact the director by phone, by email, or in person **before** the absence. *Even if a student is sick during the school day, the parent must call or email the band directors.*

Other reasons for absence will be handled on an individual basis. Parents, please contact the directors when problems arise. The band directors will decide if any conflict will be excused or unexcused.

Students and/or parents should communicate with directors and coaches well in advance when there is a conflict between a performance and a Jenison High School sporting event. All persons involved i.e. coach, director, and administrator (as well as parent and/or student if necessary), will reach a decision that will be in the best interest of the student, performing ensemble, and athletic team.

Unexcused absences will be counted as a "0" in the performance category of a student's grade. Unexcused absences from performances include the following:

Work conflicts – Students with jobs **MUST** communicate with their employers in advance so proper scheduling can take place. (This includes babysitting.)

Special events such as parties, dinners for birthdays, etc.

Visiting relatives

In all circumstances, a phone call or email from a parent to the band directors is required.

NOTIFICATION OF ABSENCES FOR A REHEARSAL OR SECTIONAL

Parents must call or email the band directors to **state the specific reason** for any absences (or tardies) from a rehearsal or sectional. Illness, school functions or special problems may be excused. Excessive absences or tardies from rehearsals and sectionals will affect the student's grade. Work, babysitting, or heavy homework/studying loads will **NOT** be excused absences.

TARDINESS

Be on time for all rehearsals and other commitments. Students are expected to be in their seats (or standing at attention in the basics block for Marching Band), ready to play and with all necessary materials at the designated time. Students will be allowed two unexcused tardies per semester. The third offense will result in an hour detention after school. The fourth offense will result in a phone call to the parents. A fifth offense will result in the student's grade being lowered by one letter. Repeated tardiness thereafter will result in a conference with the student, parent and administrator.

MARCHING BAND PAYMENT NOTIFICATION & AGREEMENT FORM

The cost of Marching Band for the 2017 season will be \$950.00* per student. This fee includes expenses for Band Camp, show shirt, uniform cleaning, transportation, State, Regional, and National competitions, and operating costs. Note that for freshmen there are additional expenses for uniform needs such as marching shoes, black Jenison Bands shirt, gloves and shako box. (Please refer to the Uniform Costs page included in this packet.)

*A \$100 credit will be issued to any family who completes 10 volunteer credits, bringing the cost of participation to \$850.00. Additionally, a \$50 credit will be issued to any family who completes two mandatory work shifts at the Jenison Invitational, bringing the cost of participation to **\$800.00**. The volunteer credit program will be discussed in detail at our *mandatory marching band parent meeting* (for all new *and returning* marching band parents) on June 5 at 7:00 at the Jenison Center for the Arts.

A \$100.00 non-refundable deposit and the signed agreement form will be due for each marching band student by Monday, May 1. To assist with budgeting and try to spread out and minimize the impact of the band fee, the remaining cost will be broken into six (6) installment payments with due dates beginning Monday, June 5, and ending with the final payment due on Monday, November 6. Parents may use **current available** credits to offset payment amounts. (See credit postings on the band website or the bulletin board in the Band Room for updated credit totals.) In order for the Jenison Band to uphold its fiscal responsibilities, it is vital that all participants in the program do their part to make each payment on time.

Payments may be made at any time using a credit or debit card. This is most likely the easiest payment method available! Simply visit the Jenison Bands website (www.jenisonbands.org) and click on the link labeled "Credits/Band Payments" for instructions on how to register for PaySchool and begin using it for your student's payments.

Parents who have more than one child in Marching Band may deduct \$50 per child from the band fee. This discount may only be taken from the last installment payment. **Please note the deposit and first installment payment must be paid IN FULL for each child.**

In accordance with the Band Booster Bylaws, Article XIII, Section 1, *The Band Office must receive payment greater than the estimated cost of Band Camp prior to the student attending Band Camp.* In addition, Article XIII, Section 3 stipulates: *All outstanding payments due, less accumulated student credits if any, must be paid in full before the student will be allowed to participate in any further band activities that may require payment(s), such as: Band Camp, Marching Band trips, or Winter Guard.*

Jenison Public Schools is pleased to provide some need-based financial assistance to families who qualify for free or reduced lunch, and are willing to participate in and help with Booster fundraisers. There are numerous fundraising opportunities available to help reduce the cost of Marching Band, including the SCRIP Program.
