Friday, November 3

Dress Up Day for State Championships!

2:50 Percussion, color guard, and tubas load semi.
6:30 Load buses and depart for GVSU. **All band members must wear your Jenison Bands t-shirt, shakos and shoes (Dinkles) for this rehearsal!** Color Guard, wear white tops and black dancewear.
6:45 Unload semi, begin rehearsal @ GVSU Turf Fieldhouse
8:15ish Snack break
9:30 Rehearsal ends; load semi
10:00 Return to JHS; unload semi

Saturday, November 4

You will need money for one fast food stop (dinner) for this trip.

11:30 a.m. Rehearsal begins
1:45 Rehearsal ends. Load semi, then load garment bag, shako box, and instruments on buses as follows: *Flutes, Clarinets* - on bus; *Saxes, Mellos* - Bus 1; *Trombones, Baritones* - Bus 2; *Trumpets, Tubas* - Bus 3; *CG equipment* - Bus 4
Lay garment bags flat in the first bay of YOUR bus. Shako boxes go on the bus with you. This would be a good time for a healthy snack, but **nobody leaves campus!**
2:50 Load buses
3:00 Leave Jenison High School
Fast food dinner en route to Ford Field (approx. 5:15)
Rest stop to change into FULL uniform
7:00 Arrive at Ford Field. Buses will drop you off so you may enter Ford Field together and use restrooms.
7:35 Meet in designated spot (TBA) to walk back to parking lot together.
8:05 Warmup in parking lot (431 Macomb, 48226)
8:55 Move to Ford Field tunnel in SINGLE FILE, IN THIS ORDER: Front Ensemble, Props, Winds, Guard, Battery (Beaubien to Beacon)
9:05 Move to Inside Warmup
9:15-9:40 Indoor Warmup (Area A)
9:45 Report to gate and move onto field staging area
10:00 Performance

Immediately following performance, all students helping with props or moving equipment should exit the field into the Side 1 Tunnel (where we entered). Make sure all pit instruments, props, and equipment are moved into the tunnel and packed tight to the right side of the tunnel, then return to the Side 1 Endzone for the Group Photo. Immediately after the photo is taken, Drum Majors should report to the tunnel to prepare for Awards.

10:30 Flight II Awards Ceremony
10:55 Awards Ceremony concludes. All students move as a group to our warmup parking lot to meet and load the semi. You will change out of uniform on the buses and pick up your snack for the ride home.
11:30 Leave Ford Field.
2:30 a.m. Return to Jenison High School. Make sure the band room is clean and orderly before leaving campus.

Ford Field Parking Deck will cost \$6.00. It is located on St. Antoine St. across from Gate G of Ford Field. (This is most likely your cheapest and closest option!) Ford Field Parking Lots #4 & 5 will also be available for use. Other parking facilities nearest to Ford Field/Comerica Park will cost more; parking farther away from these areas may cost less. *The People Mover* runs in a loop around Detroit and has many stations near parking facilities.
