David Williamson is co-founder of the Central Florida Freethought Community (CFFC), an organization of atheists and Humanists focused on the separation of state and building a thriving secular community in the Greater Orlando area. Locally, he is a member of the Central Florida Commission on Religious Freedom, is Secretary of the Florida Humanist Association, and co-coordinator of the organization's conference FREEFLO. David serves 2 national organizations. He is on the Advisory Board of the Freethought Equality Fund and a Florida State Representative for the Freedom From Religion Foundation.

David Williamson is co-founder of the Central Florida Freethought Community (CFFC), a local non-profit organization of atheists, Humanists, and religious skeptics of many labels who seek to preserve the separation of state and church through activism in the Greater Orlando area and across Florida.

The CFFC is one of many organizations in the Orlando Coalition of Reason who are building a strong social community and network of family, friends, and colleagues for Central Floridians who do not believe in a god.

David, his wife and co-founder, Jocelyn Williamson, along with other members of the organization's board discuss atheism, Humanism, and the value of secular government in various events including those hosted by the Interfaith Council of Central Florida, Valencia' College's Peace and Justice Institute, the University of Central Florida's Office of Diversity and Inclusion, and the Rollins College Office of Religious Life.

David is ordained by the Humanist Society as a Humanist celebrant, a designation is awarded to those who serve as ambassadors to Humanism as a leader, ceremony officiant, and scholar of Humanism. He serves as the Secretary for the Florida Humanist Association (FHA) and as their conference co-coordinator for FREEFLO. He is a member of the Central Florida Commission on Religious Freedom. He is a co-organizer of the Freethought Cruise. He is a Florida State Representative for the Freedom From Religion Foundation. He serves on the Advisory Board of the Freethought Equality Fund, a Political Action Committee with the bold mission to change the face of American politics and achieve equality by increasing the number of open Humanists and atheists in public office at all levels of government.

In 2013 he was presented with the Florida Humanist Association's "Humanist of the Year" award and in 2016 received the Freedom From Religion Foundation "Nothing Fails Like Prayer" award for a secular invocation he conducted for a Florida city council.

David moved from Sarasota to the Orlando area in 2012 where he met and married his wife, Jocelyn. He works in the field of occupational health and safety and is a proud father, stepfather, and US Navy veteran.
