### Treasurer's Report:

### Director's Report:

- This will be Mr. Guerra's last week with us.
- Saturday the entire band will travel to Cedar Falls high school to perform at the State Large Group Festival. Performance is at 10:40 a.m.
- Saturday night is our Homecoming Concert at 7:30 p.m. The concert will feature the concert band and the fusion band. All alumni are invited to bring their instrument and play with the band on a march and the fight song. Admission will be \$5.
- The band will be playing at graduation and will be marching in the Memorial Day Parade.
- Planning is underway for winter drumline.

### Old Business:

- \$200 was given to the family of Gregg Marolf in which we received a thank you note that if went towards the Gregg Marolf Memorial Scholarship Fund. They will be giving out a scholarship this year for \$500 and hope to be able to continue the tradition for many years to come!
- Mr. Omarzu still waiting to hear from Cathy in regards to the exact hours for the Steve's Ace Fundraiser on Saturday, May 13<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, May 14<sup>th</sup>.
- The school is in the process of bidding trailers. (\$5,000 - \$7,000 range)

That would put us at two routes with one driver per route and two runners per route. Roughly one hour putting up and one hour and fifteen minutes taking down. On May 20<sup>th</sup> or May 21<sup>st</sup> Mike would like to have four kids lined up for clean-up/maintenance. Jill Doyle suggested having an incentive to get volunteers to sign up.
- Per Mr. Omarzu the travel agent suggested the Holiday Bowl which is around New Year's, the Hollywood X-Mas Parade in which we would have to leave the day after Thanksgiving and the Rose Bowl which would be a big process to get in and would cost around \$2,000 per person (7 days) w/flying.
- There will be a volunteer spot in place for the Memorial Day Pancake Breakfast sign up to get new parents involved. It was suggested that we ask for donations of fresh fruit, pancake mix, syrup, milk, butter, etc. Band kid's parents are also invited.

### Fundraising:

- It was decided there will be (3) \$500 winners for the cash raffle. Proceeds will go towards the new trailer. We will start selling July 1<sup>st</sup>.
