Children's Community Charter School

Discovery Club offers a variety of activities to enrich your child's life both socially and physically while providing a safe after school environment. Arts, crafts, organized games and an ongoing homework table lend to the fun of Discovery Club.

**WHEN:** Every day school is in session. We follow the Children's Community Charter School calendar.

**HOURS:** End of school day until 5:30 p.m.  
A late charge equal to one day of our daily rate will be charged for any child left after 5:45pm.

**LOCATION:** School Library Building 877-2227 ex.14

**COST:** Yearly Membership Fee at Registration \$10.00  
Monday-Thursday \$11.00/daily  
Fridays and Minimum days \$12.00/Early Release

Payment can be made three ways:

  - C. Drop box at the Recreation Center
- Payment will not be taken at Discovery Club

PRE-PAYMENT IS REQUIRED IN THE FORM OF CASH, MONEY ORDER, CHECK, DEBIT OR CREDIT CARD. THIS MAKES IT POSSIBLE FOR US TO PLAN FOR STAFF AND ACTIVITIES FOR EACH DAY.

**MAKE UP DAYS:** All make-up days to be used the month in which they are accrued.

**Information:** We will need written permission for your child to walk home or leave Discovery Club to attend other activities. Please include the date and time you want your child to leave.

Emergency Numbers:

Your child will only be allowed to go home with people listed on your emergency form. Please send a signed and dated note if your child is to leave with anyone not on the emergency form.

Bus Information from Ponderosa to Children's Community Charter School:

Bus Route #2 Picks up at Ponderosa and stops at the Charter School at 2:09. Please contact PUSD transportation department for cost of bus pass.

Behavior Policy:

Children are expected to adhere to School and Discovery Club rules. If a child exhibits unacceptable behaviors, a "time out" will be used. Continued demonstrations of unacceptable behaviors will result in a phone call for the child to be picked up from Discovery Club. If behavior continues to be unacceptable, or if a child demonstrates excessive or dangerous behavior, the child will be dismissed from the program. The Recreation Supervisor will make the final decision on removal of a participant from the program. Discovery Club is designed as a group activity. Your child needs to be able to participate as part of this group.
