

FCCS Membership Meeting Highlights

Below are the highlights from the board meeting that occurred on Monday, November 6th, 2023.

- With the cold weather coming in strong last week there were a few very chilly classrooms. Currently, we have small space heaters that are helping our six areas of concern; (2) kindergartens, (2) 2nd grade rooms, and (2) 4th grade rooms. Contractors have been brought in to analyze and estimate repairs or replacement of the HVAC systems. Space heaters are not on overnight to reduce potential fire hazards in the school. The rooms will be chilly in the morning as the heater will be on only for an hour prior to arrival. We are aware of the impending cold spell this winter season and are making plans to address the comfort and safety needs of scholars and teachers.
- The History Curriculum review per the BOE/FCPS guidelines has been completed by Admin and received by the BOT. The next steps in the process will begin over the next few weeks with information being sent to the community for review, discussion and evaluation, please look for more information over the next month.
- Mr. Conroy presented the Head of School Report and the goals from the School Improvement Plan.
- The PTC shared that American Education Week will be the week of Nov 13-17. Students will create thank yous for staff in art or enrichment. The NJHS will be setting up a table for visitors to create thank you cards for staff. There will be a sign-up sheet for visitors. Piesgiving will be held on November 20th.
