

**Health Care is a Human Right
Photo Petition Campaign Guide
"Supply List"**

- Prepare a carry bag with these supplies available and ready to be used when there is an opportunity to take Photo Petitions
- Red Photo Petition Poster (8-1/2 x 11 printed from PDF). Bring about 6 copies. You will be placing the posters in a clear plastic cover so they should last through many uses
- Use clear non-glare plastic page covers for 8-1/2 x 11 Red Photo Petition Posters if possible. The non-glare plastic page covers reduce glare and improve quality of Photo Petition. Have extra available
- Dry Erase Markers, Black. Bring 2 or 3 black dry erase markers with plenty of ink in them to have petitioners write on the Clear Plastic Covers over the Red Photo Petition Posters
- Dry Eraser. Bring one dry eraser to clean the plastic covers
- Plenty of Photo Petition Image and Audio Release Forms
- HCAO Healthcare Is A Human Right Brochure (Being Updated)
- Digital Camera with charged batteries. Bring a set of extra batteries. Set the camera to take images smaller than 5mb
- Miscellaneous items: Pens, some water, towels (paper or cloth)
- Table with folding chairs as needed
- Bring clipboards so people can fill out release forms as they wait
- HCAO Healthcare Is A Human Right 11x17 Poster and easel (optional). Download and print 11x17 display poster or create you own. You can customize your poster by covering the example photo with a 4x6 photo from your area
