



Key Talking Points for the Oregon Health Care Study Bill **(HB 2828)**

- The legislature passed HB 3260, The Oregon Health Care Study Bill, in 2013. We are back in 2015 with HB 2828 to fund the bill's mandated study and assure its completion for the 2017 legislature's consideration.
 - The estimated cost of the study is \$200,000
 - 12 to 15 months is the estimated study duration
 - The Oregon Health Authority will oversee the study's completion
- The Oregon Health Care Study is focused on determining the best way to fund and affordably provide comprehensive health care to all residents of Oregon.
- By focusing on health care finance transformation HB 2828 builds on the very successful health care delivery transformation bill HB 3650 which passed in 2011. HB 3650 created Oregon's globally funded CCOs which presently serve the Medicaid population and will expand to serve some public unions in 2015.
- The Oregon Health Care Study bill has wide support from groups representing business, labor, faith communities, minorities and others; and passed in 2013 with by-partisan support.
- It is HCAO's must-pass bill in 2015 which will provide sound data and recommendations to the legislature for the next logical and necessary step forward in Oregon's overall health care transformation process.
