
U.S. healthcare... At The Tipping Point

**"The Healthcare Movie"** tells the story of how the health care systems in Canada and the United States evolved to be so completely different, when in the 1950s they were essentially the same. It exposes the intense campaigns in the U.S. since the early 1900's to dissuade the American public from supporting national health care while in Canada a similar struggle during the 1960s led to its universal medical care system at a much lower per capita cost. Every day people are dying or going bankrupt due to the ills of the United States system.

These movies will be offered again in coming months. Each stands alone; they may be viewed equally well in any order. Each movie is about 30 minutes long. With additional time for discussion before and after the film each session will last about 60 – 70 minutes long.
