Welcome! We are blessed by your presence today! We hope that you will find the following information helpful.

Information Request: We ask each attendee to fill out the attached attendance flap and place it in the offering plate each week. Our church uses this information for Prairie Hill Evangelical Free Church communications only. **Information will not be shared with outside sources.**

This Morning's Offering is for those who call Prairie Hill their church home. You are our guest. Please do not feel obligated to participate.

Nurseries and Classrooms are located upstairs. Please see our Welcome Booth attendant for room locations.

Children ages 4 – 5th Grade: Children join their families in the 10:30 a.m. Worship Service. During the message portion of the service, children **age 4 through 5th grade** are dismissed for **Children's Church and 345s**. Teachers meet children in the narthex outside of the sanctuary and escort them to the classroom. Children through 2nd grade must be picked up by parent/guardian in Room 207 following the service.

The Welcome Center is located to the left as you exit the sanctuary.

Emergency Information

AED: The AED is located across the hallway from the Welcome Booth.

In the Event of a Fire: Everyone is asked to exit the building immediately. All upstairs classrooms and nurseries will be evacuated through the upper level doors and children will be taken to the east side of the parking lot nearest the high school. **Parents please do not rush upstairs to find your children** as this may hinder the evacuation process. Families should reunite on the east side of the parking lot.

In the Event of Severe Weather: Children in the upper level of the church will be ushered down the west stairway (closest to the sanctuary) and into the lower level bathrooms. If time does not allow for this, children will be taken into the upper level bathrooms. **Parents please do not rush upstairs to find your children** as this could cause delay in the evacuation of children to a safer area. Adults may move into the two small rooms on either side of the platform in the sanctuary, the lower level library area by the elevators, the offices, or under the stairwells.

Bulletin: The photo on our bulletin today was used by permission from Compassion International. Compassion had more than 500 child development centers in India until they were forced to leave in March. Compassion had serviced the needy children of India for almost fifty years. There were approximately 147,000 children enrolled in the child development centers when Compassion and other NGO's ((non-governmental organizations) had no choice but to leave. But it's not the end of the story. In Isaiah 55:11 (God's Word Translation) we read "My word, which comes from my mouth, is like the rain and snow. It will not come back to me without results. It will accomplish whatever I want and achieve whatever I send it to do."




