KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students will need to come to school with the following supplies along with \$15.00 (I will buy the rest of the needed supplies)

School Supplies:

Backpack (not on wheels)
1 1/2 inch clear view binder
1 plastic, yellow 2-pocket folder
(without prongs)
1 ream of white copy paper

Adventure Supplies - Keep on hand at home

Tennis shoes/Hiking shoes
Snow clothes snow pants, gloves, hat, boots
Camping - sleeping bag (30 degree rating)
Water bottle

Make sure the student's name is on their portfolio, backpack, and paint shirt.

1st/2nd GRADE

\$20.00 for supplies (We will shop in bulk for tissues, Clorox wipes, paper towels, pencils, colored pencils, crayons, glue, markers, folders, etc.)

Please write your child's name, in marker, **only** on the following items: paint shirt and paints.

Supplies you provide:

1 paint shirt (old t-shirt, sleeves that are not too long)
50 clear TOP LOADING sheet protectors - place 1st grade students' IN binder
2-inch clear view binder (**All 1st grade and new 2nd grade students**)
1 ream white copy paper
1 Crayola watercolor paints

Adventure supplies - kept at home

Sturdy tennis shoes/hiking boots
Water bottle with name on it
Snow clothing: pants, gloves, hat, boots
Camping: warm sleeping bag, plastic bowl and spoon, and cup for hot chocolate

3rd/4th Grade

*You will not need to put your child's name on these items, as we collect them for community buckets.

School Supplies:

- 40 Ticonderoga only pencils
- 2 spiral notebooks
- 1 composition book
- 1 pkg. wide ruled notebook paper
- 12 pack twist-up colored pencils
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 pkg. Post It tabs/flags
- 1 pink pearl eraser
- 4 Expo dry erase markers
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 rolls of papers towels
- 1 container Lysol or Clorox wipes
- 1 bottle hand sanitizer
- 3 large boxes of tissue
- 1 box of Band-Aids
- 1 ream white copy paper
- 50 clear TOP LOADING sheet protectors
- 4 inch clear view binder (3rd grade & new PCCS students)-smaller sizes not acceptable
- 2 each plastic pocket folders with prongs (not a 3 ring binder)

Adventure Supplies - Keep on hand at home:

- Medium size backpack with double shoulder straps
- Hiking boots/lace up snow boots
- Snow Clothes - Pants, gloves, hat/headband
- Sleeping bag - rated at 0 degrees or lower
- Flashlight (headlamp is best)
- Wool socks
- Raincoat
- Hat/headband

5th/6th Grade

Upper elementary students need to come to school with the following supplies along with \$35.00 (we will purchase the rest of the needed supplies):

1½ inch clear-view binder for math (5th and 6th)

2 inch binder for other subjects

2 3-hole pencil bags with zipper (one for each binder)

1 ream white copy paper

A public Library Card

"jump drive" with a small amount of storage (for backing up files and taking e-copies from school to home and home to school).

Other expenses throughout the year (so you can start budgeting now):

- Our crew will go on one overnight backpacking trips. We will buy the food for the trip and will ask for about \$20.00
- We will be taking downhill ski lessons at Pebble Creek. Lessons are about \$75, which includes rental fee. If your child has their own equipment, it will be a little less.

Required for Adventure Activities (have on hand at home):

Sun Hat

Hiking shoes or boots

Thick, wool socks

Tennis shoes

Long underwear (preferable NOT cotton)

Head lamp or flashlight

Unbreakable water bottle that won't leak

Snow boots with laces

Waterproof snow pants, jacket, warm hat, gloves

Backpacking pack (internal frame) - the school has a limited supply of these.

Packable lightweight sleeping bag (rated to -10 degrees F.)
