KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten students will need to come to school with the following supplies.

School Supplies:

Backpack (not on wheels)
1 1/2 inch clear-view, 3-ring binder
1 **plastic**, yellow 2-pocket folder
(without prongs)
1 ream of white copy paper
10 glue sticks
1/2 inch clear-view, 3-ring binder

Adventure Supplies - Keep on hand at home

Tennis shoes/Hiking shoes
Snow clothes: snow pants, gloves, hat, boots
Camping - sleeping bag (30 degree rating)
Water bottle

Make sure the student's name is on their portfolio, backpack, and paint shirt.

1st/2nd GRADE

1 paint shirt (old t-shirt, sleeves that are not too long)
50 clear top loading heavy duty page protectors (1st graders please put in binder)
2-inch clear view binder for all 1st graders and new 2nd graders
1 ream of white copy paper
1 Crayola set of watercolor paints
1 box of 24 count Crayola crayons
5 glue sticks
1 box of Kleenex
1 container of disinfecting wipes
1 blue pocket folder
1 yellow pocket folder
1 folder of color of choice
30 Ticonderoga pencils
1 package of sticky notes
1 roll of paper towels
1 package of washable markers
1 box of bandaids
12 colored pencils (Griggs and Kaper only)
2 dry erase markers

Adventure Supplies-Keep at home

Sturdy tennis shoes/hiking boots
Water bottle with name on it
Snow clothing: pants, gloves, hat, boots
Camping: warm sleeping bag, plastic bowl and spoon, and cup for hot chocolate

3rd/4th Grade

*You will not need to put your child's name on these items, as we collect them for community buckets.

School Supplies:

- 24 Ticonderoga only pencils
- 3 composition books
- 12 pack twist-up colored pencils
- 5 glue sticks
- 1 pkg. Post It tabs/flags
- 1 pink pearl eraser
- 1 pair of scissors **if you are left handed**
- 2 rolls of papers towels
- 1 container Lysol or Clorox wipes
- 3 large boxes of tissue
- 1 box Ziplock bags - any size
- 1 ream white copy paper
- 75-100 clear TOP LOADING sheet protectors
- 4 inch clear view binder (3rd grade & new PCCS students)-smaller sizes not acceptable
- 2 each plastic pocket folders with prongs (not a 3 ring binder)

Adventure Supplies - Keep on hand at home:

- Medium size backpack with double shoulder straps
- Hiking boots/lace up snow boots
- Snow Clothes - Pants, gloves, hat/headband
- Sleeping bag - rated at 0 degrees or lower
- Flashlight (headlamp is best)
- Wool socks
- Raincoat
- Hat/headband

5th/6th Grade

- 4 dozen pencils (Ticonderoga or Dixon)
- 1 package pencil top erasers
- 2 ultra-fine point sharpies
- 2 boxes of tissues/Kleenex
- 2 packages pink erasers (3 or 4 pack)
- 1- Calculator- basic calculator dollar variety
- 1 package Elmer's glue sticks (2-3 per) (ONLY: 6th grade)
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue (ONLY: 5th grade)
- 100 clear TOP LOADING sheet protectors (Avery or Costco brand are sturdiest)
- 1 package Crayola watercolor paint 8 color or 16 color
- 4 Expo dry erase markers (thin or thick)
- Plastic homework folder without prongs (Mead is the most durable)
- 2 container Lysol or Clorox wipes
- 7 wide-ruled 1 subject notebooks
- 24 pack Crayola colored pencils
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch clear-view plastic math binder
- 2-inch clear-view work binder
- 3-inch clear-view White Portfolio Binder (ONLY: 5th grade and new 6th graders)
- 2 3-hole pencil bags with zipper (one per binder)
- 1 ream white copy paper
- 3 packages wide-rule loose leaf notebook paper

Please note: Crayola has the truest color the most pigment as well as durability.

7th/8th Grade

Your student should come to the first day of school with the following items.

- 40 pencils (students are responsible for supplying their own pencils)
- 4 mechanical pencils with refills
- 3 70-page spiral notebooks
- 1 graphing composition notebook
- 1 zippered 3-ring binder
- 3 3-hole punch plastic folders
- 3 black or blue pens
- 1 ream white copy paper
- 2 pkg 100 sheets lined paper
- 50 top loading sheet protectors
- 1 3-inch clear view 3-ring binder (**7th grade and new 8th graders only**)
- 3 glue sticks
- 1 handheld pencil sharpener
- 1 pair regular scissors
- 1 scientific calculator

Bring these supplies if your last name begins with:

- A-F 1 pk dry erase markers
- G-M 1 roll paper towels
- N-R 1 box tissues
- S-Z 1 container wipes
