April 12, 2016

1. The retirement of Katie Phillips will be recognized with a sad send-off on May 15.
2. Our church will sponsor a “Human Library” during Swedish Days, a growing movement featuring Human “Books” : gay, African-American, Muslim, etc. who may be chosen to carry on a conversation with someone to foster more understanding.
