The Prime Sports Institute Training Room is an open-to-the public athletic training facility that provides access to state-of-the art recovery tools and services, including: compression boots, muscle stimulation, full immersion ice bath, ice/heat pack therapy, concussion screening and management, therapeutic tools and on-site injury screens.

We are seeking a qualified and hardworking athletic trainer interested in working within a unique clinical setting.

Candidate expected to be a complete and versatile health care provider as part of our clinical team with emphasis on the following competencies and responsibilities:

- Manage daily operations of the Training Room
- Oversee flow of all patients as scheduled
- Perform injury and performance screens
- Provide patient care, treatment, and service in a continuous and coordinated manner under the direction of the referring physician.
- The performance of educational responsibilities specific to the needs of each individual patient. This includes but is not limited to: exercise instruction, answering patient questions regarding treatment plans, rehabilitation options, and insurance inquiries.
- Participate in on-going education, including in-services, training, and other activities, to maintain and improve individual competence.
- Review recovery equipment operation. Instruct/educate patients and clients on proper use and care.
- Perform outreach and marketing services to local gyms, running clubs and fitness studios.
- Strong desire to advance your skills
- Eagerness and open-mindedness in learning the Prime System
- Good people skills, communication skills, and professional presentation to allow interactions with clients, parents, coaches, and other Prime team members

- Proficiency in electronic medical record use and database management

- Ability to deliver patient care in a positive, caring, and empathetic manner while working as part of a broader clinical team to assure the highest standards of patient centered care
- Experience or strong competency in concussion management and RTP
- Well developed manual skills or willingness to attend advanced certification course to include ART, Graston etc...
- Strong skills in marketing, sales, and business development
