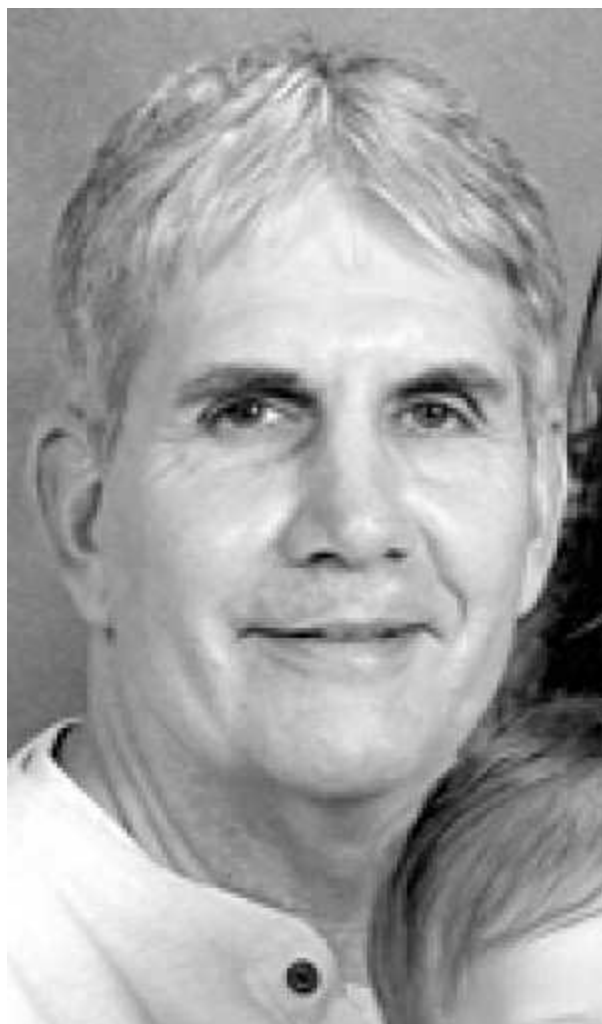




Steven D. Sebastian
