LONGVIEW, Wash. -- One of the three men who died in the crash involving a train and a shuttle van Wednesday, grew up in Vancouver, friends told KGW.

Chris Loehr graduated from Skyview High School. The 28-year-old also served in the



U.S. Army, including two tours in Iraq.

Friends said he had just landed his "dream job" at Burlington Northern Santa Fe as an apprentice conductor.

Friends described him as a fantastic person. He also enjoyed bodybuilding in his free time.

After returning home from serving in the military, Loehr landed what friends described as his "dream job" working for Burlington Northern Santa Fe. He was hired in January as a conductor trainee and was working out of Port Bay, Wash.
