Train accident results in a fatality

An investigation is underway following a Nov. 6 accident in which a Union Pacific employee was struck and killed by a train east of Lusk.

According to Niobrara County Sheriff Rick Zerbe, the Federal Railroad Administration, Wyoming Department of Criminal Investigation and the sheriff's office are working together to complete the investigation.

Niobrara County Coroner Lisa Mellott confirmed a man was struck by a train and died as a result. The name of the man will not be released until the investigation is completed, she said.

No further information was provided by the railroad or law enforcement agencies as of press time.
