Authorities ID Man Killed In Minneapolis Rail Yard Accident

MINNEAPOLIS (WCCO) — Authorities have identified a man who died Monday in an accident while unloading track material at a facility in northeast Minneapolis.

A spokesperson for Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway said the employee was unloading the material when a train on another track struck the material, which then fell on the employee. The company identified the employee Tuesday as 29-year-old Tyrell Anderson.

BNSF Railway officials said Anderson was a trackman on a traveling construction gang from Nebraska. He had more than eight years of service with BNSF and is survived by his parents and a son.

Nebraska man identified as rail worker killed

MINNEAPOLIS — A Nebraska man has been identified as a BNSF Railway employee killed in a rail yard accident in Minneapolis.

The Hennepin County Medical Examiner's office identified the man Wednesday as 29-year-old Tyrell Anderson of Gering, Nebraska. According to the office, Anderson died of "multiple blunt force injuries" sustained while unloading track material Monday morning.

BNSF spokeswoman Amy McBeth has said a locomotive passing on another track hit the material, causing it to fall on top of the worker. Deputy Fire Chief Todd White said he was part of an eight-person crew working in the area.

The medical examiner's office says the accident is being investigated by BNSF, the National Transportation Safety Board and the Federal Railroad Administration.
