

Duties of the RWU International Solidarity Liaison

1. The International Solidarity Liaison shall:
 - a. Act as an official RWU representative when initiating and building relationships with workers' organizations and movements – particularly those of railroad workers – around the world.
 - b. Seek out railroad worker unions, organizations and movements around the world that are interested in working in solidarity with US railroad workers and RWU.
 - c. Initiate resolutions of support and otherwise build awareness of and solidarity with such unions, organizations and movements.
 - d. Ensure that proper and adequate publicity is given to such unions, organizations and movements by utilizing the RWU newsletter, Facebook Page, list serve and other media.
 - e. When feasible, make trips abroad to visit with leaders and rank and file workers, attend conferences, rallies, pickets and solidarity actions.
 - f. Maintain contact with individuals and organizations that RWU has established a solidarity relationship with and report on progress made at regular ISC meetings.
 - g. Act as the official RWU host when foreign workers visit to attend Conventions, conferences and other events sponsored by RWU.
