Seminary Intern for Worship/Spiritual Life

Position Title: Seminary Intern for Worship & Spiritual Life

Purpose: The Seminary Intern for Worship & Spiritual Life works alongside camp leadership to provide for the spiritual nurture and worship of campers, staff and guests. The intern will provide primary leadership for Bible study and worship of the Summer Camping program and will also implement other strategies to strengthen the spiritual environment of the camp. The intern will also participate in the daily life of the camp community and provide Christian witness through work and play.

Accountability: The direct line of supervision for the Intern for Worship and Spiritual Life is to the Assistant Director and, ultimately, to the Executive Director.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be a growing Christian, committed to the Gospel of Jesus Christ
- Must be willing to engage in ministry and mission of the particular setting, recognizing our connection as a Presbyterian Church (USA) Camp and Conference Center
- Be able to work with others cooperatively and creatively
- Be flexible and willing to support the overall life and ministry that occurs at camp
- Be in good health, able to participate in strenuous activities
- Be able to carry out the directions of your supervisors
- Be a seminarian at an accredited seminary with preference given to a PC(USA) seminary
- Be available for internship from Mid-May through early August.

Responsibilities of Seminary Intern for Worship/Spiritual Life Position include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Engage in a plan for experiential learning to support goals of an internship experience.
2. Provide for the overall worship and spiritual life of the camp.
3. Prepare regular worship opportunities for campers, staff and guests in coordination with the Executive Director and other staff.
4. Lead weekly staff devotional.
5. Lead at least one community worship experience during the term of internship.
6. Support summer staff through leadership and resourcing for Bible studies.
7. Participate fully in the camp community life, residing with a camper group during the week when assigned.
8. Love unconditionally all participants by demonstrating and sharing your Christian faith simply and honestly in word and deed.
9. Complete assigned duties as directed or requested by your immediate supervisor and/or the Executive Director.
10. Abide by the personnel policies of the Outdoor Ministries Division of Trinity Presbytery, the Fellowship Camp and Conference Center and the Presbytery.
11. Abide by the community standards for camp.
12. Work, laugh, and have fun.
13. Other duties and responsibilities as assigned.
