- After years of praying for her two lost siblings, one church member had one sibling purchase a Bible at Walmart and another sibling express a desire to see *The Story of Samson at Sight & Sound*. Our church member is eager to use the Bible to share the Biblical story of Samson before they go to the show. God is good...All the time!
