Joy Club

Today on Senior Adult Sunday, we would like to highlight our seniors. Here at East Shore Baptist Church we are blessed with children and younger families, but we are also blessed with a significant amount of senior

adults. Though they may have accumulated some years of experience, they're quite an active group serving Christ and enjoying life.

The Senior Ministry at East Shore is known as the “JOY Club.” JOY stands for Jesus-first, others-second, yourself-last. They seek to live out this title by engaging in a variety of ministries. From knitting and collecting items for missionaries and mission trips, preparing gift bags for our church's outreach events, crafting prayer messages to be included with restaurant tips, and numerous other projects to share Christ's love. They also provide invaluable services to shut-ins and the ill in our church. The JOY Club is very supportive of the overall mission of the church to share in God's kingdom work in our community.

Each month there are at least 3 JOY Club events. First, the monthly JOY Club meeting is on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 PM in the Multi-Purpose Room. The meeting includes a devotion, a shared meal, and then an activity. These activities can vary from guest speakers to ministry projects. Second, the Knife and Fork Club meets the first Tuesday of the month at various local restaurants to build relationships among the members of East Shore. Third, the single ladies of the JOY Club get together on the last Tuesday of the month. Various other service projects, trips, and events are scheduled throughout the year. We would love to have you join us!
