EVANGELISM NOTES

Usually we list some examples of how East Shore Baptist Church (ESBC) members have “SHARED THE GOSPEL” this past week. We hope these examples encourage you to pray for opportunities to share about Christ AND then—when the opportunities present themselves—give you the courage to follow through.

Today we would like to encourage you to SHARE THE GOSPEL by telling others about the Story of the Bible.

There are four main acts to the Story of the Bible:

1. *The Creation: In the beginning, God created everything to be perfect. There was no sickness or disease and everything lived in harmony (Gen. 1:1; Ps. 90:2).*
2. *The Fall: Man rebelled against a loving God. Sin entered into the world and into every human heart. Everything is now distorted and broken. Everyone is guilty before God (Rom. 3:10, 19).*
3. *The Rescue: Jesus, who is God, came to rescue people by His life, death, and resurrection. By faith alone in Him, sinners can have their sin forgiven and enjoy eternal life with Him (Luke 19:10; 1 Pet. 3:18; Gal. 1:4).*
4. *The Restoration: God will someday restore everything to the way that it was supposed to be, and those who trust in Jesus will get to enjoy eternity with God (Rev. 21:1, 3-4).*

Hershey Volunteers

A unique way our church raises money for our missions is through volunteering time at the Hershey Entertainment Complex's Food and Beverage Department and Rides

Department. These volunteer shifts may be located at Hersheypark, Hersheypark Stadium, Hersheypark Arena, or the GIANT Center.
