### HEY CHURCH...LET'S GO FOR A BIKE RIDE!

Come join us on Saturday evening, July 23<sup>rd</sup>, at 6:30 p.m. for a bike ride on the beautiful Enola Low Grade Rail Trail.

**Who** – This trip is open to all church members. You just need to own (or borrow) a bicycle and be able to pedal an easy 10 miles on a very flat trail.

**What** – The Enola Low Grade Rail Trail (ironically located nowhere near Enola) is one of the premier trails on the East Coast. The 12 foot wide trail contains four inches of special trail mix creating an ideal surface for bicyclists. The trail, located in Washington Boro, PA (about an hour from here) is spectacular. From the parking lot (which includes portable restrooms) you bike out five miles with views of the Susquehanna River directly on your right side and rock cliffs on your left. Local climbers use the cliffs to practice rappelling. At the end of the trail is a fantastic overlook of the Safe Harbor Dam and trestle bridge (with informational signs posted to educate you on the purpose of the dam, etc.). After a rest break, we'll turn around and pedal the easy 5 miles back to the parking lot. If we time it right, we will be riding into the sun as it sets on the sparkling Susquehanna River. After that, we'll pack up our bikes and—you guessed it—go get some ice cream! (The bike ride should take 60 – 90 minutes.)

**Where** – Enola Low Grade Rail Trail, 2459 River Road, Washington Boro, Pa 17582. We can meet at the trail, or if some desire to meet at the church and car pool from there, we can make that happen as well. (Also, if you don't have a way to transport your bike, see Tom Toone and we'll try to make that happen as well).

**When** – Saturday evening, July 23, 2016, leaving from the trail-head at 6:30 p.m. The reason for that start time is we are hoping to catch the sunset over the river. (If some decide to carpool from church, we would leave the church at 5:30 p.m.)

**Why** – Because as a church we haven't done something like this before and, of course, because of the 3F's – Fun, Food, & Fellowship!!!

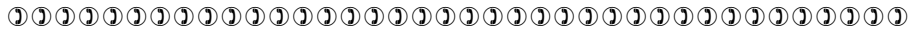

## PRAYER CHAIN MINISTRY TEAM

We are looking for a special team of prayer warriors. Many of you pray through things like our prayer list, membership lists, and/or HFG requests. But we are looking for a team of people who will commit to respond to timely requests for special prayer. As part of this team you will be put on a special list to receive a Prayer Request phone blast - utilizing our new unattended phone call system - generated by requests that come into the church office, and will include pertinent prayer needs. As part of the team we ask that you have at least one prayer partner on the list (you can have more, including outside of the prayer chain), who you will call and pray with upon receipt of the prayer request. We will also ask if you prefer to pray in the day-time or evening (this will help identify who to partner with). If interested and the Lord is leading you, please sign-up. We will allow 3 weeks for initial sign-up, and then put the list out to team members to choose partners (or we can assign). People can be added to the chain and list later if they desire to be a part of it. Prayer makes a difference! Thank you for *prayerfully* considering this. Pastor Brian



**Concept:** Very shortly our church will begin utilizing an "**Unattended Phone Call**" service. What this means is that we will have the ability to blast out a voice message to each phone number we have on an office generated Member Call List. Our intent is to utilize this for critical announcements such as significant church-wide events, church closing (such as due to snow) or class cancelations, and even the passing of a church member. We also are looking to utilize this service in a revamped Prayer Chain ministry (see above).

**How it Works:** What will happen is that you will receive a call with a voice message. It most likely will show up on your caller ID as coming from the church (we will be setting it up shortly and will get the precise info to you). You can either answer and listen, or let it go to your voice-mail. As the cost per call is \$0.10 per minute per completed call, the calls will be brief. They may not include all the information we would like, but will include the most important.

**What we need from you:** We need to make sure we have correct phone information - i.e. (1) preference of home or cell phone; (2) correct phone number, and (3) who wants to receive the call. We can send it to one family member/household number, or to both husband and wife. Because this is a cost/call service, we ask that only those who most desire the information get on the list. Moms and dads can forward the information on to their children living at home. Please fill out the information below, tear off that bottom section and place in the offering basket.
