HEY CHURCH...LET'S GO FOR A BIKE RIDE!

Come join us on Saturday evening, July 23rd, at 6:30 p.m. for a bike ride on the beautiful Enola Low Grade Rail Trail.

Who – This trip is open to all church members. You just need to own (or borrow) a bicycle and be able to pedal an easy 10 miles on a very flat trail.

What – The Enola Low Grade Rail Trail (ironically located nowhere near Enola) is one of the premier trails on the East Coast. The 12 foot wide trail contains four inches of special trail mix creating an ideal surface for bicyclists. The trail, located in Washington Boro, PA (about an hour from here) is spectacular. From the parking lot (which includes portable restrooms) you bike out five miles with views of the Susquehanna River directly on your right side and rock cliffs on your left. Local climbers use the cliffs to practice rappelling. At the end of the trail is a fantastic overlook of the Safe Harbor Dam and trestle bridge (with informational signs posted to educate you on the purpose of the dam, etc.). After a rest break, we'll turn around and pedal the easy 5 miles back to the parking lot. If we time it right, we will be riding into the sun as it sets on the sparkling Susquehanna River. After that, we'll pack up our bikes and—you guessed it—go get some ice cream! (The bike ride should take 60 – 90 minutes.)

Where – Enola Low Grade Rail Trail, 2459 River Road, Washington Boro, Pa 17582. We can meet at the trail, or if some desire to meet at the church and car pool from there, we can make that happen as well. (Also, if you don't have a way to transport your bike, see Tom Toone and we'll try to make that happen as well).

When – Saturday evening, July 23, 2016, leaving from the trail-head at 6:30 p.m. The reason for that start time is we are hoping to catch the sunset over the river. (If some decide to carpool from church, we would leave the church at 5:30 p.m.)

Why – Because as a church we haven't done something like this before and, of course, because of the 3F's – Fun, Food, & Fellowship!!!
