Here are some examples of how East Shore Baptist Church (ESBC) members have “SHARED THE GOSPEL” this past week. These examples are meant to encourage YOU to Share the Gospel where you live, work, and play.

*-One ESBC member prayed with his doctor who is a believer.*

*-Another member gave a Christian book to a friend who had expressed an interest in the author and his topic. Our member plans to follow-up on a discussion of the book and seek opportunities to share the gospel with his friend.*

*-Still another member shared that when she arrived at the health facility to have dialysis completed, the nurse expressed apprehension about finding an adequate vein to draw blood from. Our member said, “Don’t worry. I prayed this morning that you would find a good vein”. The nurse expressed gratitude for the prayer and everything worked out well.*

*-And finally, a member of our church was walking in her neighborhood and a neighbor asked her how she was doing. Instead of responding “fine” as she would typically do, our member said, “My Savior Jesus is in heaven. How could I not be doing fine?”. The neighbor said she really needed to hear that as she had just received an unsettling phone call about a health concern in her family. Our church member then said, “Can I pray for you?”. And they prayed together...right there...in the middle of the sidewalk!*
