MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT!

Super Church



In August, we will be spotlighting Children's Ministries at East Shore Baptist Church. This week we will be looking at Super Church.

Who is it for?-The program is for children in 5th and 6th grade.

When does it occur?-It occurs on the second and fourth Sundays throughout the school year during our Sunday morning worship service.

What is it?-Super Church is a program designed to transition pre-teens from the Kidmo Program into our general worship service.

Why is it necessary?-Kids today are dealing with issues that were unfathomable for ten or twelve year olds fifteen to twenty years ago. In Super Church we hit these issues head on with what the Bible says regarding issues such as eating disorders, bullying, emotions, family relationships, and more. The program uses small groups, breakouts, videos, and games in order to not only give kids the knowledge on what the Bible teaches on these issues, but also guide them in how to apply this knowledge.
