EVANGELISM NOTES

Here are some examples of how East Shore Baptist Church (ESBC) members have “SHARED THE GOSPEL” this past week. These examples are meant to encourage YOU to Share the Gospel where you live, work, and play.

-One ESBC member invited a co-worker to participate with him in an on-line Bible devotion (S.O.A.P. = Scripture/Observation/Application/Prayer). Now the co-worker's wife would like to participate in the devotion as well.

-Another member shared with her nurse after an out-patient procedure that she had prayed beforehand for the surgical team. The nurse appreciated the gesture and wished that more patients who profess to be believers would “walk the talk”.

-Still another member shared that he was teasing a co-worker for interrupting him when he was praying. This light-hearted banter led to an actual opportunity for the gospel to be shared.

-And finally, a member of one of our Sunday School classes had an acquaintance at work come up to him at the end of a long, hot day and out of the blue say that he was trying to get more “religious” and even recently purchased an inexpensive Bible at Ollie's. Our SS class member asked him some questions about salvation and it appeared his colleague didn't have a clue...but he was interested in learning more. This ESBC class member invited his co-worker to come sit in the parking lot in his air-conditioned truck and he then prayerfully and slowly took his new friend through the plan of salvation—using the recently purchased discount Bible from Ollie's. And praise God...the worker who was initially seeking “religion” opted instead for a personal relationship and that very day made Jesus Christ his Savior and Lord!!!

So, what have YOU done to SHARE THE GOSPEL lately? Pray for opportunities and be ready when the Lord gives them to you!!

Please place these items in the box under the table at the end of the hallway.

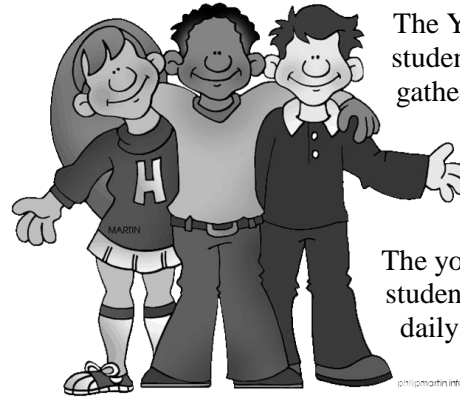
OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT!

Youth Ministry

The Youth Ministry at East Shore is for students in 6th to 12th grade. The ministry gathers on Wednesday evenings for our weekly meeting. The Wednesday meetings include a time of teaching, prayer, and an icebreaker activity.



The youth ministry focuses on teaching students the importance of the Bible in their daily lives. We emphasize how the students can apply God's Word to the issues of the day. We use the Word of Life

Student Ministry Teaching Curriculum and cover areas related to Jesus Christ, God the Father, End Times, Man, Sin, Salvation, and the Bible. We also encourage students to complete a daily quiet time and memorize scripture.

In addition, there are fun activities that the group participates in. The students attend Reverb (an all-night event in Philadelphia), Snow Camp in New York in January, and World Vision's 30 Hour Famine.

We can always use individuals to assist with preparing a weekly snack and would love to welcome those who want to offer their time to disciple students.
