MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT!



Several members of East Shore are involved with **Transport for Christ**. Transport for Christ is a mission organization dedicated to reaching, supporting and encouraging truck drivers. The organization's mission is to lead truck drivers as well as the trucking community to Jesus Christ and help them grow in their faith. Transport for Christ currently ministers in Russia, Zambia, and 45 locations in North America.

Since truck drivers are frequently on the road or away from home, it can be difficult for them to connect with a church or hear the Word of God taught. Transport for Christ is how we as a church strive to reach those in an often lonely profession who may not otherwise hear the gospel.

Some members of our church serve as chaplains through Transport for Christ. Our chaplains are available at a local truck stop to talk to truckers about Jesus Christ, pray for them, and meet their spiritual needs. Additional volunteers would always be appreciated.

ESBC SPORTSMAN'S CLUB

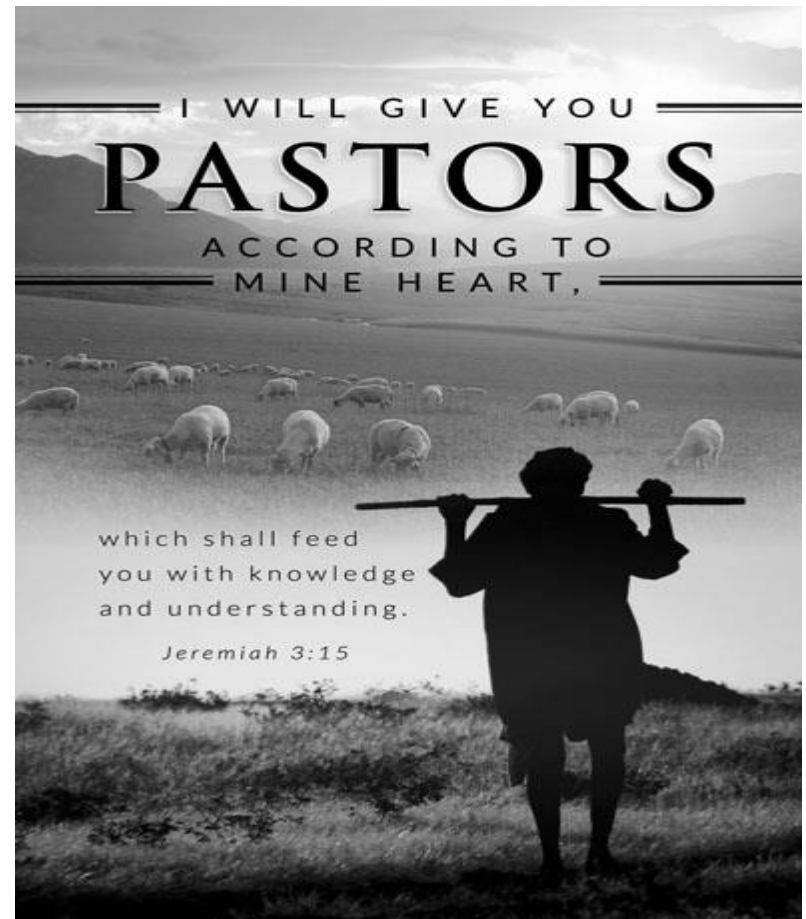
