A Home Fellowship Group (HFG) ministry creates an environment of spiritual intimacy among believers, while affording the opportunity for individuals to ask questions in a non-threatening environment.

This ministry is focused around a small group mentality that participates in good food, real fellowship, heart-felt worship and genuine prayer. Following the model of Acts 2:42, HFGs meet weekly in the comfort of our homes.

This approach to “doing church” allows us to minister and disciple believers in a way that produces true biblical transformation in people’s lives and allows true biblical community because we’re able to get into the “meat” of life, discuss real life situations, and discuss how the weekly sermon applies specifically to you and your needs.

The HFG ministry creates opportunities to minister one-on-one and deal not only with the issues of life, but also with deeply rooted heart issues. HFGs help believers foster spiritual and practical disciplines and enable them to respond to an ever increasingly dark world by being fundamentally changed to the glory of God!
