Three times a year we have special offerings at East Shore Baptist Church. One of these offerings runs through Easter: the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering.

100% of the gifts through the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering support the North American Mission Board (NAMB), the missionary sending agency of the Southern Baptist Convention for the United States, Canada, and their territories.

What is the money used for? Here are some examples of items North American missionaries need and how much they cost:

\$1 – A dozen pencils, a pair of scissor, clear tape, or other school supply items to assist a child.

\$1 – 20 evangelistic tracts to distribute in a neighborhood where a new church is starting.

\$2 – 50 flyers to advertise a special event for a new church start.

\$2 – Subway pass used to visit a prospect for a new church.

\$5 – Ream of construction paper for use in a Backyard Bible Club.

\$10 – A literacy skill book for adult reading/writing in English and a paperback Bible.

\$10 – “Jesus” video in another language.

\$15 – Sunday morning snacks in a new church start.

\$20 – Promotional flyers for an evangelistic block party in a multicultural community.

\$25 – Refreshments for children attending a Bible Study as part of a new church start.

\$50 – A week-long camping experience for one inner city child.

\$75 – Building rental for one Sunday worship service for a new church.

\$100 – Printing postcards to advertise the start of a new church.
