PRAYERS FOR THE DR MISSION TRIP

Praise – Marcello, Word of Life Director for the Dominican Republic, received enough funds to construct 4 units to house children this summer for camp. Their plan is to have the housing ready for hosting Compassion International children starting our first week in country.

Prayer Needs – (1) A number of our team are getting hit with unusual expenses that are making raising funds difficult. The enemy no doubt knows what our purpose and heart is, and he is looking to discourage some from going. We are doing all that we can, especially through prayer, to make sure they can go, but we need your prayers as well. Also, (2) It looks like we have the very real possibility of getting a container and shipping it to the camp in time for our trip. We seem to have a handle on getting a container loaded and to the port, but are praying about cost of putting on board ship, and then getting it to camp once it arrives in the DR. Please pray that this will come together. This is a big deal, and the equipment and supplies we can send to the camp will be a huge help in their mission.

The Cooperative Program is Southern Baptists' unified plan of giving through which cooperating Southern Baptist churches give a percentage of their undesignated receipts in support of state and convention missions and ministries.
