EVANGELISM NOTES

Here are some examples of how East Shore Baptist Church (ESBC) members have “**SHARED THE GOSPEL**” this past week. These examples are meant to encourage **YOU** to Share the Gospel where you live, work, and play.

-One member of ESBC struck up a conversation with a local store owner. The owner kept referring to her daughter in the past tense. Our member asked what happened and the store owner—who began to tear up--shared that her adult daughter had been killed in an attempted purse snatching. Our member prayed then and there in the store with the owner and is going to be intentional in going back to the store to share and LISTEN some more.

-Other church members initiated “God conversations” with their neighbors over such things as a broken lawnmower as well as over items at a store that were on sale.

-And finally, a member of our church felt the Lord telling her to put her phone away as she waited in a local doctor’s office and just “be available. Within minutes she was involved in a deep—albeit strange—spiritual discussion with another person in the waiting room. The message here...but the electronics away and make yourself AVAILABLE for God to use you.

So, what have YOU done to SHARE THE GOSPEL lately? Pray for opportunities and be ready when the Lord gives them to you!!

Joy Club

Today on Senior Adult Sunday, we would like to highlight our seniors. Here at East Shore Baptist Church we are blessed with children and younger families, but we are also blessed with a significant amount of senior adults. Though they may have accumulated some years of experience, they're quite an active group serving Christ and enjoying life.

The Senior Ministry at East Shore is known as the "JOY Club." JOY stands for Jesus-first, others-second, yourself-last. They seek to live out this title by engaging in a variety of ministries. From knitting and collecting items for missionaries and mission trips, preparing gift bags for our church's outreach events, crafting prayer messages to be included with restaurant tips, and numerous other projects to share Christ's love. They also provide invaluable services to shut-ins and the ill in our church. The JOY Club is very supportive of the overall mission of the church to share in God's kingdom work in our community.

Each month there are at least 3 JOY Club events. First, the monthly JOY Club meeting is on the third Tuesday of each month at 6:00 PM in the Multi-Purpose Room. WORD OF LIFE WOMEN'S CONFERENCE
