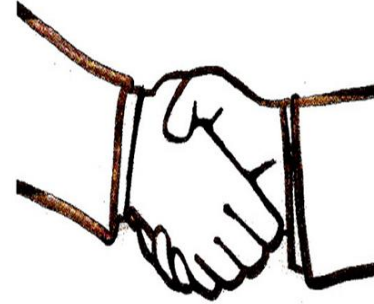
### WOMEN'S SUMMER GET TOGETHER

Praise – Terry Wisser (Word of Life Missionary) was able to secure a 20-foot container that will cost us \$4000 to ship from Word of Life, NY – to – Word of Life camp in DR. This is a huge blessing, as they are in desperate need of more kitchen equipment to feed children and youth (and mission teams) that will be using the camp. Word of Life, NY donated some used commercial kitchen appliances and more. We will now be able to collect and send heavier items the camp needs to function better for the Kingdom. Praise God we are able to help out with \$2000 from our Missions Reserves. Prayer Needs – (1) Terry was able to get a 40' shipping container, but now he has to get a new date for shipment. (2) Pray that all the items that need to be shipped in the container will arrive on time. Pastor Harrison will be taking things up for the container soon. (3) Pray for the health and family needs of the team that is going.
