Here are some examples of how East Shore Baptist Church (ESBC) members have "SHARED THE GOSPEL" this past week. These examples are meant to encourage YOU to Share the Gospel where you live, work, and play.

- One member of ESBC talked to a Muslim co-worker about the difference between a religion and a relationship.
- A Sunday School classmate had an opportunity to talk about the Lord with one of his tenants.

- And finally, a group from the church are on a mission trip in the Dominican Republic. Several have had the opportunity to share the gospel. Please pray for the team as they continue to talk about faith in Jesus Christ.
