### THE JOY CLUB

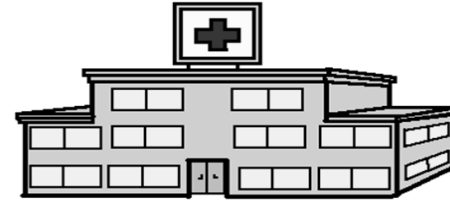
