-One of our ESBC members visits local nursing homes with her dog as part of a pet therapy service. Recently she struck up a communication with a resident who allowed our member to pray with him.

-Two of our members are helping their adult child through a difficult personal situation. They have modeled prayer and the gospel message throughout the ordeal and their adult child is expressing an interest in coming to church to learn more.

-Another member spoke with his dentist about our recent trip to the Dominican Republic and the gospel message that was shared there.

-And yet another member shared with a relative one of our Christian pamphlets (available outside the church office) that dealt with a certain health issue from a godly perspective. The member encouraged their relative to pray and take their troubles to the Lord.

-And finally, one of our church members engaged a family member in a discussion about salvation. The family member believes that there are many ways to God. Our church member gently shared that only Jesus is the way and the truth and the life. And that no one comes to the Father except through him (John 14:6).
